



## Small Group Guide: Give Me The Spring's (Judges 1:12-15 NKJV)

**Summary:** This iOS a sermon around the story of Aksa asking Caleb for springs, and it urges listeners to “ask for more”: a fresh personal infilling of the Holy Spirit, a fresh move of the Spirit in their church, and a fresh outpouring on the nation, followed by invitations for salvation and Spirit baptism.

### Key Takeaways

#### 1. What It Means to Be Pentecostal

- Speaking in tongues
- Believing in miracles
- Standing on God's promises
- Believing in all five office gifts (apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, teacher)
- Believing women are anointed for ministry

#### Three Things to Ask God For:

1. A fresh Pentecost in your personal life
2. A fresh move of the Spirit in your local church
3. A fresh outpouring on our nation

### Discussion Questions:

#### 1. Personal Pentecost:

- Pastor Joel mentioned that we tend to "leak the Holy Ghost" because of the world we live in. What does that look like practically? What causes you to feel spiritually "dry"?
- Have you experienced being "filled afresh" with the Holy Spirit? Share that experience with the group.

#### 2. Rivers of Living Water:

- The sermon mentioned that rivers must flow, not sit stagnant. What "rivers" (tongues, love, faith, generosity, evangelism, prophecy, miracles) have you experienced flowing from your life?

#### 3. Fresh Pentecost in Your Life:

- On a scale of 1-10, how "filled" do you feel with the Holy Spirit right now? What would it look like for you to move toward a 10?
- What specific step can you take this week to pursue a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit?

# Prophetic Applications For The Week

Choose ONE of the following to practice this week:

1. **Daily Prayer in Tongues:** Set aside 15 minutes each day to pray in the Spirit, asking God for a fresh baptism and for rivers to flow.
2. **Ask for Something:** Like Aksa, step out and ask God for something specific you've been hesitant to request. Journal about the experience.
3. **Intercession for Revival:** Pray specifically for 10 minutes each day for a fresh move of God in:
  - **Your personal life**
  - **Arise Church**
  - **Our nation (especially Gen Z and college campuses)**
4. **Flexibility Exercise:** Identify one area where you've been resistant to change in your church or spiritual life. Pray and ask God to help you embrace whatever He's doing, even if it's uncomfortable.
