International Sunday

SCRIPTURE

Acts 17: 26-27

Ephesians 2:11-22

OVERVIEW

On our first International Sunday, we celebrated the blessing of diversity in the nations, languages and cultural identities in our Church.

We were reminded that diversity has always been part of God's design right from creation, and how in Christ we share common citizenship, as members of one household, unified to reflect God's glory.

DISCUSSION

God is glorified in the unity of the nations through Christ in the following ways:

- Through our reconciliation with Him (we have access)
- Through our pursuit of Him (we seek him)
- Through our citizenship that binds us (members of one household)
- Through our collective worship of Him (we are a holy temple / residence of the holy spirit)
- Through continually "being built" together
 (building blocks after the Christ the cornerstone)

Spend some time discussing last Sunday, what stood out for you? How did God speak to you? Read through the passage. Discuss how we can grow in glorifying God as a diverse people, united in Christ.
