

Old & New Ephesians 4:17 - 5:21

SCRIPTURE

Ephesians 4:17 - 5:21

OVERVIEW

Paul emphasizes maturity in this part of the letter, with the aim of helping the church understand that the gospel transforms every aspect of our lives. Our salvation is not only for the purpose of getting into heaven, allowing us to live however we please now because it doesn't matter. Instead, our salvation transforms both today and eternity. Maturity is a lifelong journey of growing up in the Lord, and Paul stresses that two keys to grasping maturity are identity and actions.

Identity

Throughout this letter, Paul has made it clear that in God's eyes, there are only two identities, and only one can be true of us. We are either a "gentile" outside of Christ or a "beloved child" in Christ. To grow in maturity, we need to have a God-given identity as a beloved child and walk in the confidence that this is a gift from God freely given because of His grace and mercy.

Actions

Paul also shows that although our identity is found in Jesus and is solely because of His work, we play an important role in our maturity. We do not seek to live out God's call to gain His affection, but instead, we live in response to His affection for us. Our maturity flows from our relationship with God, not for a relationship with Him.
