CLIMATE CHANGE

OYERYIEW

Climate change is arguably the biggest topical issue our world faces today. It sounds an alarm on the damaging effects that human production, industrialisation and consumption patterns have on natural systems and cycles which ironically sustains all life forms!

The earth is our home, but not ours to use and abuse as we wish (cf: Gen 2:15) and the Bible gives clear reasons why Christians should embrace a "calling to creation care". A call to responsible stewardship of nature and all the resources God has blessed us with, as an act of worship!

REFLECTION

Our response to the call to creation care can be five-fold.

- 1. **Repentance:** Choosing to turn from wasteful patterns of production & consumption that characterizes modern society.
- 2. **Humility:** Learning to live within limits; A recognition that we don't own the earth and a commitment to serve God through its care.
- 3. **Setting an example:** Living out creation care as a Christian value
- 4. **Speaking up:** On behalf of the poor and

- marginalized; and worst affected
- 5. **Prayer:** For those affected, for Christians and local churches, governments and all leaders etc (climate news = Prayer topics!)
