### Overview

On Sunday Mike Betts spoke to the whole church about a new prayer initiative being launched across the Relational Mission family of churches. We heard that we are launching *an humble attempt* to birth a revolution in prayer.

Mike showed us how for the apostle Paul prayer was of primary importance, encouraging and asking churches to partner with him in prayer. We saw how many people finds prayer difficult but God himself will help us. Mike also highlighted that prayer is most fervent in times of crisis. Mike journeyed us through seeing the value of prayer in a corporate setting, helping us realise we can't do this on our own but need help.

We then looked at the two-fold nature of the title "Enough". Firstly seeing how Christ truly is enough, His power, grace and love shows us we can trust in him. Secondly declaring enough of the difficulties and circumstances we are facing.

We heard how these evenings first happening on Friday 13th March will help us as a church to hear the apostolic mission we are part of alongside praying into current issues happening. We base our prayers on what God has promised and we haven't seen come into its fullness, Enough is all about asking! Finally Mike helped us see that prayer really does work! We may not see fruit immediately but we can believe we will see change in years to come because of our prayer.
