SCRIPTURE

1 Peter 1: 13 - 2: 3

SCRIPTURE CONTEXT

This passage paints a picture of our call to be a holy people in the light of our eternal home. The foundation is our identity in Christ: loved and obedient children being made into His image, bought at a price for an eternal future with Him. Because of Jesus' sacrifice, we are able to live holy lives of purity and sincere love for others. And as we outwork this, we grow in maturity of faith and our ability to have the eternal perspective that helps sustain us.
