- 4. What are we tempted to rejoice and put our trust in above God? Look at I Peter v3 onwards. What do you find most encouraging in those 'reasons to rejoice?'
- 5. Do you see Sunday morning gatherings as a 'ski lift' or a 'mountain summit?'
