The Holy Spirit is the person with whom we _____.
For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God...In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit. (Ephesians 2:18-19,22)

For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. (Romans 8:6)
