


MARY WASHES THE FEET OF JESUS

# Mary Magdalene

---

*As Jesus next steps led him to Bethany which means (The House of Pain) bringing him closer to his destiny. He never avoided the opportunity to minister to people along the way.*



*Mary heard that Jesus was in the house of Simon and therefore, she invited herself into a space where religious leaders would not have invited her.*

*“Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper, 7 There came unto him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on his head, as he sat at meat. 8 But when his disciples saw it, they had indignation, saying, To what purpose is this waste? 9 For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor. 10 When Jesus understood it, he said unto them, Why trouble ye the woman? for she hath wrought a good work upon me. 11 For ye have the poor always with you; but me ye have not always. 12 For in that she hath poured this ointment on my body, she did it for my burial. 13 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her”. (Matthew-26:6-13)*

*While religious leaders stand to judge people by their pass, Jesus is transforming their life and preparing them for their future. For she will be one of the first to see him on Easter morning!*



## The Plot Begins

Then the chief priests, the scribes, and the elders of the people assembled at the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas, 4 and plotted to take Jesus by trickery and kill Him. 5 But they said, “Not during the feast, lest there be an uproar among the people.” (Matthew-26:3-5)



# Judas Plans To Betray Jesus

**T**hen one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests <sup>15</sup> and said, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?” And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver. <sup>16</sup> So from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him.  
(Matthew-26:14-16)

*Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born.”*


*25 Then Judas, who was betraying Him, answered and said, “Rabbi, is it I?”*
