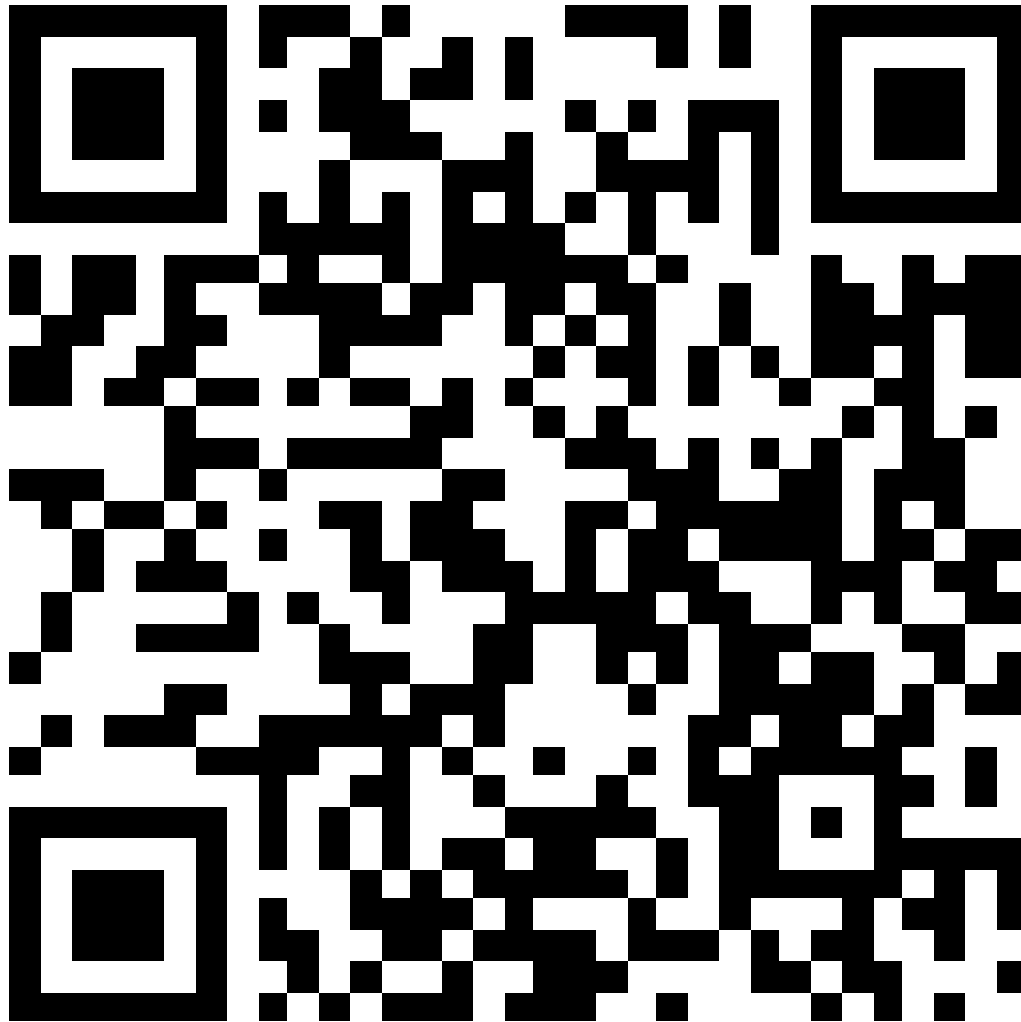


Everyone Needs a “Red” Bible

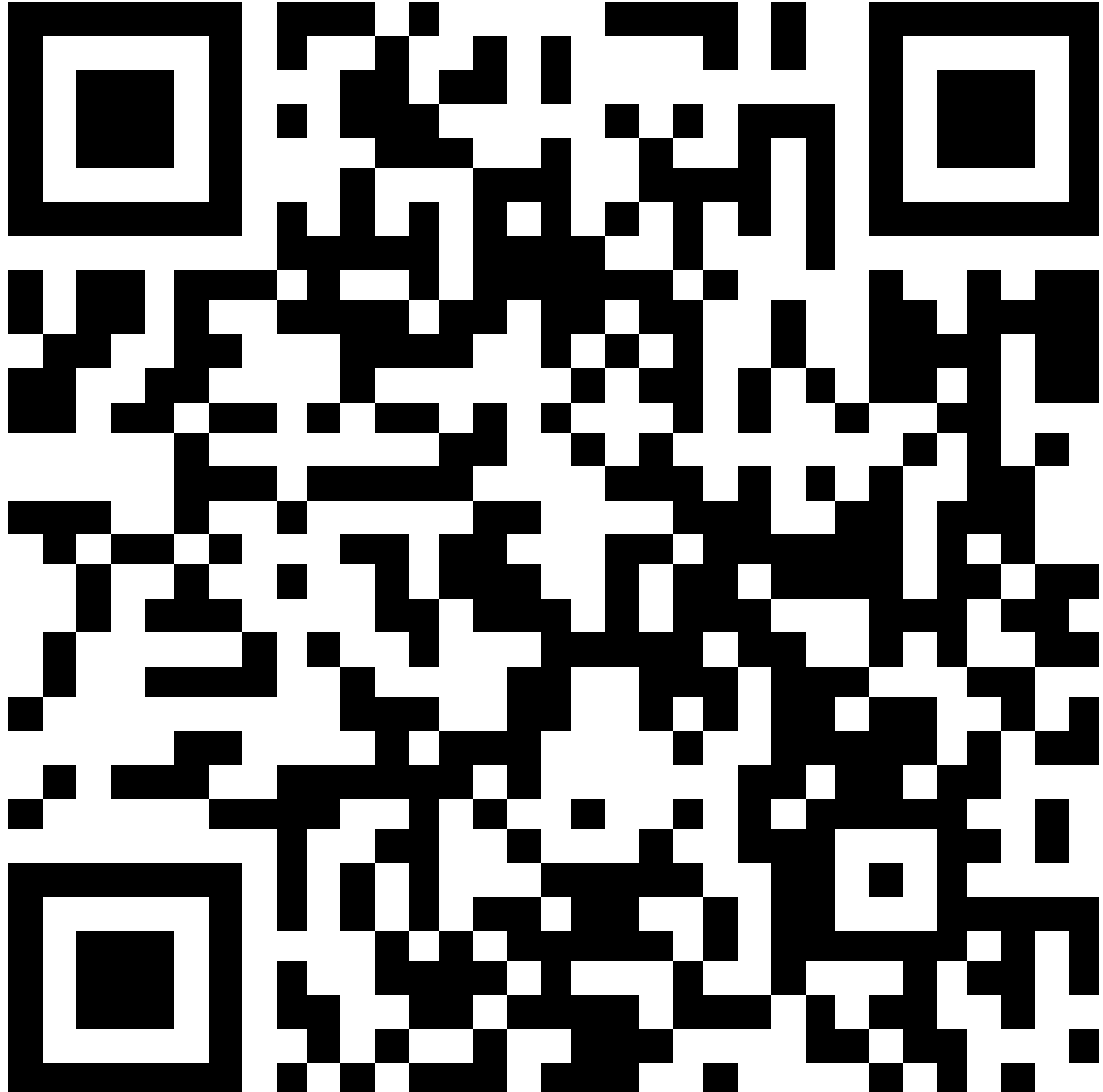
The best place to start reading for most people is the Gospel of John.
