John 12:12-19; Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:29-40

The word king actually means “one who is able.” Reluctant to accept the title before now, Jesus arrives at Jerusalem and finally receives this accolade in its fullest sense—He is the Eternal King, the promised Messiah, the One Who comes in the name of the Lord.
