Mark's Gospel has been described as a passion narrative with a lengthy introduction. Seen d ıg

traditionally, Mark places the arrival into Jerusalem on Sunday, cursing of the fig tree and clearing the Temple on Monday, final conspiracy and anointing on Wednesday, Passover an arrest on Thursday evening, trial and crucifixion on Friday, and resurrection on the following Sunday. Here the Messiah enters His capital city in clear fulfillment of OT prophecy.

2. Generational Yearning for Salvation (vv.7-10)

3. Quiet Assessment before the Storm (v.11)
