

John 14-21: The Word Made Complete

“Human Injustice on Display”

John 18:12-14, 19-24, 28-38a

The arrest took place in the dead of night, cowardly in its execution. The Jewish trials were sham affairs meant to cover a previously determined verdict with a façade of legality. Roman confirmation of guilt involved a gutless politician taking the path of least inconvenience. In each encounter, Jesus was confident, unintimidated and in command.
