

Simplicity of the Gospel
1 Corinthians 15:1-10
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Jesus Christ is resurrected from the dead. This fact is the foundation of the Gospel and the security of the Christian hope for salvation and eternal life. The Gospel is grounded in theological revelation, historical reality, and personal testimony. Every Jesus-follower requires a solid grasp of the content that is the Gospel. This is the heart of our “good news.”

1. Gospel Progression (vv.1, 2)
 - Proclamation - “which I proclaimed”
 - Regeneration - “which you received”
 - Sanctification - “in which you stand”
 - Glorification - “by which you are saved”
 - Endurance - “unless you believed for nothing”
2. Gospel Foundation (vv.3-7)
 - Death, Burial, Resurrection
 - According to the Scriptures
 - Eyewitness Verification
3. Gospel Transformation (vv.8-10a)
 - Evaluation of Sinfulness
 - Experience of Grace
