Vision - Discipleship Drives Direction

1. **Desired Outcome:** “I know I need vision to set a Christ-centered culture of discipleship in my home for myself and those in my home.”
2. **Framework:** “Vision is not about control and outcomes ... it’s about obedience and consistency.”

Proverbs 29:18 (ESV) *“Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint, but blessed is he who keeps the law.”*

Breakdown:

- “Prophetic vision” = revealed direction from God
- Not personal ambition, but **God-centered clarity**
- Without vision there is drift, reaction, chaos
- With vision there is restraint, intentionality, order, and blessing

“You already have a culture for your home. Vision determines whether you’re shaping it or just living inside of it.”

3. **What’s the vision for your home?**
 - a. Goals are what we want to achieve
 - b. Vision is who we are becoming in Christ
 - c. Formation should be daily, ordinary, and consistent
 - d. Vision Stretches beyond a season for yourself and your family
