Community - Discipleship Takes a Team

1. **Desired Outcome:** “I understand that God designed discipleship to happen in community, and I will intentionally pursue and invite godly community into the formation of my life and my home.”
2. **Framework:** “God builds disciples through *shared life, shared truth, and shared responsibility.*”

Hebrews 10:24–25 (ESV) “And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together... but encouraging one another...”

Breakdown:

- CONSIDER = *intentional thought about others*
- STIR UP = *provoke toward love and growth*
- MEET TOGETHER = *consistent*
- ENCOURAGE = *speak strength into one another*

TRUTH: “*You cannot experience ‘one another’ commands by yourself.*”

Let's pause for an audit:

Answer the following:

- Who consistently speaks truth into my life?
- Who has permission to challenge me?
- Who knows what is really happening in my home?
- Who is modeling Christ to my children (if applicable)?

Consider the Following:

- Am I truly known? How or why not?
- Am I truly accountable? How or why not?
- Am I spiritually supported? How or why not?
- What keeps me from a deeper biblical community?

Pause For Prayer:

Ask God to remove resistance and replace it with courage.

4. Discipleship Is Dialogue

- a. **Mark 3:14 (ESV)** “And he appointed twelve... so that they might be with him and he might send them out...”

We see Jesus:

- i. Formed in Community
- ii. Taught in Community
- iii. Sent Out from Community

Truth: “If Jesus did not disciple alone, we should not attempt to either.”
