

1 Samuel: Selected Lessons for Leaders
“Spiritual Leadership”
1 Samuel 12:1-25

Now that Israel’s new king has been duly confirmed and celebrated, Samuel closes the book on his own lengthy tenure of service as a leader for the nation. Having exonerated his character publically, he unleashes his full prophetic arsenal in evaluating Israel and calling her to faithful obedience to the One True God. This chapter climaxes the entirety of Israel’s pre-monarchial history.

3. Consistent to the End (vv.23-25)
