Psalms: Songbook of the Faithful "Book I: Foundation of Messiah's Promise" Psalms 15-24, 41

The twin themes of Psalms 1-2 emerge now with intentional clarity. Primarily consisting of songs attributed to David, Book I outlines the rise of David from shepherd boy to king and then points to the greater Son of David promised to Israel in the future. The declaration of these truths can be seen in nature, but seldom are recognized; so God has given a more personal revelation in His Law. (Book I conclusion—Psalm 41:13.)
