Mark 6:45-56

In three gospels, the account of walking on water is attached immediately to the feeding of the 5000. The follow-up miracle serves as confirmation of the previous miracle—Jesus is more than a mere provider of bread; He is the deliverer of His people from all dangers, physical and spiritual. How long would it take for His disciples to grasp this foundational reality?
