Easter, Seen and Unseen "The Invisible Conversation" Luke 23:32-46; Matthew 27:45-54; John 19:25-30

There were dozens, possibly hundreds, of onlookers milling around Golgotha hill the afternoon Jesus died on a cross under the watchful eyes of hardened Roman soldiers. Mostly, they judged the events of the day solely on the basis of what they could physically see and hear. Except for a precious few, they missed the hidden significance of His words and the Person on the other side of the conversation.

- "I assure you: Today you will be with Me in paradise." (v.43)
- "Father, into Your hands I entrust My spirit." (v.46)
- 2. Wrath and Revelation (Matthew 27:45-54)
 - "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" (v.46)
- 3. Consolation and Completion (John 19:25-30)
 - "Woman, here is your son.... Here is your mother." (vv.26, 27)
 - "I'm thirsty." (v.28)
 - "It is finished!" (v.30)
