Rain Catchers Part 1- Rain Dance

Read: 2 Kings 3:11-20

“I hear the sound of the abundance of rain!” -Pastor Ronnie Harrison

LET IT RAIN UNTIL:

- The atmosphere is cleansed.
- Our sins are washed away.
- The dry and thirsty are filled.
- The Harvest comes to full bloom.
- “The glory of the Lord covers the Earth like the waters cover the sea.”
- Families are saved.
- Marriages come back together.
- Addictions are broken.
- Dead things come back to life.

Start this season with purpose:

1. To become “thirsty” for the rain.
The challenge of the modern church is that we are dry but not thirsty.
2. To prepare for Heaven’s rain.
There is no need for Him to send what we are unprepared to catch.
3. To learn how to catch what Heaven sends.
The Rain preserves the future, releases the harvest, and reveals God’s favor.
4. To see how to seed the Heavens.
What comes down is the result of what goes up!

Read: Job 36:27, Isaiah 51:16

You seed the Heavens with your praise and with your declarations of His Word.



King Jehoram, the King of Israel, went to the King of Judah asking him to go to BATTLE with him against King Mesha, the King of Moab.

Conflict must bring collaboration.

Conflict can divide or bring unity.

There are some things that you can't do on your own.

If we are not careful, conflict will isolate us and drive us from fellowship.

(Vs. 8) Jehoram asks Jehoshaphat: "Which WAY should we go?"

VICTORY often dictates that we go through the WILDERNESS!

Sometimes the wilderness is the most direct route to deliverance.

Read: 1 Peter 1:7

(Vs. 9) "There was no water...."

Where there is no WATER there is no LIFE!

(Vs. 11) Jehoshaphat asks: "Is there a prophet of the Lord?"

Prophecy is your future in Word form!

(Vs. 14) Elisha says: "If it wasn't for JUDAH, I wouldn't even SEE you..."

Read: Psalm 3:1-3

(Vs. 15-16) Elisha said, "Bring me a minstrel", and it came to pass, when the minstrel played, that the hand of the Lord came upon him. And he said, 'Thus said the Lord...'"
