Rain Catchers Part 5- Singing in The Rain

Read: Judges 5:1-12

1. God is giving his Church a new song

God has always demonstrated His power through what looks like an inferior and seemingly insignificant force.

2. Ballads are born in battles

The words to your song come from the battles that you fight!

Every generation must fight its own battles if it's going to sing its own song!

3. We won't win the victory without the rain

Rain turns the enemy's strength into a weakness.

Read: Psalm 20:7

Rain paralyzes the purpose of the enemy.

Read: Deuteronomy 28:7

4. Epic battles require fresh anointing

There's not a valid song without a valid sacrifice.

The primary enemy to your song is entitlement, because entitlement refuses sacrifice.

In the body of Christ, our showboating must give way to sword-sharpening.

We have an entitled generation that refuses to heal because they refuse to forgive.
