

LIFE Promises In the Bible

There are many promises in the Bible of God meeting our LIFE needs for Love, Identity, Favor, and Enthusiasm. But it's easy to make the mistake of trying to grab hold of these blessings without learning to *live the kind of life that naturally produces them.* It's a spiritualized self-help process that fosters self-absorption. So we place these Scriptural affirmations in the context of worshiping God, growing in Christ, and loving one another.

Instructions

Partner with someone to minister to one another these LIFE promises from the Bible. For each verse, speak out loud your praise to God and your affirmation of his grace to you and your friend. For instance, say the first promise in this way:

"God is love... In Christ I am never separated from God's love... In Christ you are never separated from God's love."

	The Prince of Peace	At peace with God (Is. 9:6)
	The Judge	Free from condemnation (Rom. 8:1)
	The Great Reverser	The last made the first and the least made the greatest (Matt. 20:16)
Е	The God of Hope	Joyful, peaceful, and overflowing with hope (Rom. 15:13)
	The Light of the World	A light in this dark world (Jn. 8:12, Matt. 5:14)
	Living Waters	The salt of the earth to make people thirsty for God (Matt. 5:13, Jn. 7:37-39)
