<u>Frankincense – Jesus as High Priest</u>

Big Idea Jesus meets me where I am.

Malinew 1:16-25, Malinew 2:10-11

Frankincense

Physically – very expensive, practical gift – helps treat sickness and wounds Spiritually – priests burned as a fragrant offering to God (symbolizing prayers as smoke rises)

-Priests represented the people to God -Priests made sacrifices for the forgiveness of sins -Priests prayed on behalf of the people of God

Christ's action was not his alone in isolation; he fulfilled God's redemptive plan in setting us apart by his sacrificial death.
Citing again the endless repetition of Old Testament sacrifices to the same effect, they "can never take away sins."
By his decisive offering, Christ accomplished all that human sin required.
Myrrh – Jesus as Suffering Servant
Big Idea I am willing to go the distance for Jesus.
Luke 2:1-7, Matthew 2:10-11

Myrrh

- -Valuable gum like substance
- -Mentioned 17 times in the Bible
- -Occasionally used as an anesthetic Jesus cross wine mixed with myrrh
- -Most commonly known ingredient used to embalm the dead

Isaiah 53:6-7
