<u>Big Idea</u>
As a believer I am part of Christ's Body.

# Verses 22-24 God sovereignly arranged the diverse functions of the members of the human body. Applied to the church, this means that Christians who are regarded as having less important functions in the congregation are actually indispensable. Verses 25-26 The purpose of the gifts is to build one another up and to care for one another, not to

flaunt one's own spirituality.

All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is a part of it.
