Following God's Lead

<u>Big Idea</u> God has a plan for me this Christmas season.

Matthew 2:1-12

My goal for this series:

During this Christmas series "The Gift," our attention will be drawn back to the true meaning of the Christmas season. By highlighting the significance of the gifts the wise men brought to Jesus (gold, frankincense, and myrrh), we will be able to connect the symbolism within the story of Christ's birth to our relationship with Jesus. This series will provide us with new insight on the birth of Jesus to gain a deeper understanding of who He is.

The Gift: What is the gift of God?
Ephesians 2:8-9 God saved you by this grace when you believed. And you can't take dredit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boost about it.
John 4:10 Jesus replied, "If you only knew the gift God has for you and who you are speaking to, you would ask me, and I would give you living water."
Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

- 6. Pastor Kendall pointed out several gifts God gives us through Jesus. Read each set of verses together. Ephesians 2:8-9; John 4:10; Romans 5:15 -17; Romans 6:23. Which one stood out to you and why?
- 7. The wise men showed up to worship the new King, and they came bearing gifts. What gifts do you bring to God in worship?
