Sermon Questions

<u>Ice Breaker</u>: When you were young, whose approval meant the most to you? Why?

- 1. Which part of the message was most impactful for you and why?
- 2. What areas in your life are "bound up" by living for the approval of people?
- 3. Here are several challenges people-pleasers often struggle with: obsessing over what others think, feeling overly sensitive to criticism, and having a hard time saying "no." Is there one that most describes you? Why do you think you have a hard time with that particular challenge?
- 4. Pastor Kendall taught that people pleasing is a form of idolatry. If we were to prioritize Christ's approval over the approval of others, how might that change our lives and our relationships?
- 5. Galatians 1:10 says "Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant." In what ways is fearing what others think a trap?
- 6. What are some ways you can stop seeking approval from others?
- 7. What steps can you take to truly start embracing who God says you are?
- 8. Read these Additional Key Scriptures and meditate on who God says you are this week: 2 Corinthians 5:17,20,21; Ephesians 1:7, 2:10; Romans 1:7, 8:11,17,37; Matthew 5:14. Choose your favorite and tell us why.
