3 Keys to Fighting Temptation

Big Idea

Pre-Decide: I'm putting distance between myself and giving into temptaion

Genesis 39:6-12, 1 Corinthians 10:13

It's not <u>if</u> I'm tempted,	but <u>when</u> I'm tempted.
1 Corinthians 16:13	Matthew 26:41
2 Corinthians 2:9-11	1 Corinthians 10:12-13

3 Keys to Fighting Temptation

#1. Move the line.

#2. Play the movie to the end.

#3. Plan your escape **now**.
Genesis 39:6-12
Never use your disappointments
to justify your disobedience.

1 Corinthians 10:13

The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.
