Study Questions

1. What stood out to you, challenged you, or encouraged you from Sunday's sermon/service?
 2. Read Romans 1:1-7. How do these verses relate to today's scripture?
 3. The Greek word for power, "dynamis," in verse 16 means "inherent power; power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature." It can also mean "the power of performing miracles," as in Mark 6:14 "King Herod heard about this, for Jesus' name had become well known. Some were saying, 'John the Baptist has been raised from the dead, and that is why miraculous powers are at work in him.'" How do these definitions add to your understanding of the power at work in the gospel?
 4. Read 2 Timothy 1:6-8 How do these verses written from Paul to Timothy connect to the ideas in Paul's letter to the Romans?
 5. What do today's verses have to say to our current political/social situation?
 6. "Paul has discovered, through years of actually doing it, that when you announce Jesus as the crucified and risen Lord of the world something happens: the new world which was born when Jesus died and rose again comes to fresh life in the hearts, minds and lifestyles of the listeners, or at least some of them." -NT Wright
