Big Idea

My behavior and lifestyle should reflect Christ's.

1 Corinthians 11:27-30, Joshua 24:14-21

"The self-examination is the test that reveals whether their behavior and lifestyle reflect Christ's." -P. Vang
 -This is a personal self-examination for sin -A pause to reflect on my life the last few weeks -A chance to confess my sin -A time to identify as a sinner in need of God's grace -A time to say thank you to Jesus for His death, burial, and resurrection -A time to be reminded that Jesus died for me
