### Discussion Questions

Icebreaker: If you could walk through a locked door like Jesus did, where would you go first - and why?

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. When Jesus appears to the disciples behind locked doors, what does that reveal about who He is and how He meets people where they are?
3. What does Jesus say and do first when He appears to the disciples? What do his first words reveal about His heart toward the disciples? (See Luke 24:36-43 for a parallel account with more detail).
4. How do the disciples respond when they see Jesus the first time? What changes in them?
5. In what ways does this moment serve as a "door of revelation" for the disciples? What are they beginning to understand about Jesus that they didn't fully grasp before?
6. How does Jesus' interaction with Thomas reveal His attitude toward doubt and honest questions? (see also Jude 1:22,23)
7. How does Thomas' declaration, "My Lord and my God," represent a deeper level of revelation compared to earlier moments in the disciples' journey?
8. What "locked doors" (fear, doubt, uncertainty) might prevent people today from experiencing the fullness of who Jesus is? How does this passage speak into that?
9. Jesus entered a room full of fear and spoke peace. Where in your life do you need to experience His peace right now? (Philippians 4:6-7)

Optional Reflective Activity: How does this passage act as a door of revelation - moving someone from fear to peace? from doubt to belief? from limited understanding to a fuller recognition of who Jesus is?
