God is the Way Maker

Big Idea

When we can't see a way forward,
God is already at work making a way.

2 Kings 7:1-20

God Makes a Way When There Is No Way (vv. 1-2)

- Samaria was trapped.
- The situation was impossible.
- Samaria is surrounded by the Aramean army.
- There is a terrible famine inside the city.

Just because you can't see a way doesn't
mean God isn't already making one.

God Makes a Way Before We See the Way (vv. 3-8)

Four men with leprosy are sitting outside the city gate.

- They're outcasts.
- They're hungry.
- They have nowhere to go.
- They basically have three choices: stay and die, go back and die, or take a chance.

They thought they were walking toward the enemy BUT they were actually walking into God's provision.

God Makes a Way So We Can Share the Way (vv. 9-16)

The lepers find: food, water, clothing, silver....

"God Is the Way Maker"

When Israel couldn't see a way - God made a way.
When the lepers couldn't see a future - God made a way.
When the city couldn't see hope - God made a way.

Sermon Applications

Choose one or both of the following to put into practice this week.

1. Sit With The Promise

Read 2 Kings 7:1-20 again on your own this week, slowly. As you read, ask God to show you where He might already be working in your situation that you have not yet recognized.

2. Share Your Story

Think of one person in your life who needs to hear about a time God made a way for you. Commit to reaching out to that person this week — a phone call, a coffee, a text. Your story of God's faithfulness could be exactly what they need to hold on.
