Living With An Undivided Heart

Big Idea

Only Jesus satisfies, sustains, and secures.

1 John 5:21

To “keep yourself from idols” (1 John 5:21)
means to guard your heart from anything
that replaces God as the ultimate focus
and source of your love, trust, and identity.

Attachments act as barriers – like a cord tethering
a bird to the earth – that obstruct a free, loving
relationship with God. These attachments focus on
self-gratification or security rather than divine purpose.

What are some idols or attachments?

Anything taking God's place:

Wealth, career, relationships, reputation, success, hobbies, or even your own opinions/experiences

False teachers/beliefs:

As John warned against false teachers in his time, "idols" can also mean false doctrines or philosophies that distract from God's truth

Demands on your heart:

Anything that demands your ultimate love, thoughts, time, and desires, leaving you empty when unmet

How to Keep Yourself from Idols/Attachments

Active Guarding:

Identify Your Idols/Attachments

Place God at the Center

Check Your Reactions

Embrace Jesus
