Go quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and invite the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame. Go out into the country lanes and behind the hedges and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full. -Luke 14:21&23

 Every truly great Sunday Gathering experience should be aimed toward three things: 1. Magnifying the risen Christ. 2. Equipping people to live for God. 3. Sending believers out better equipped to love, serve, and share the Good News both in word and deed.

Talk It Over

- 1. What is the fanciest, most formal meal or gathering you have ever attended?
- 2. In Matthew 9:35-38, describe what Jesus saw and felt when he looked at the crowds. What do you see when you look at your neighborhood, city, and the world you live in?
- 3. What is the contrast between the harvest and the laborers, and how is it to be resolved?
- 4. How are the fields ripe where you are? Do you feel an urgency, passion, and reason to go and make Jesus known?
- 5. In Luke 14:15-24 the servant is sent to call together the guests who already RSVP'd "yes" to the party. Why do you think they say yes and then say no?
- 6. What do you notice about the second and third groups that get invited into the party? (Roads and country lanes would include foreign travelers.) What does this reveal about the Kingdom of God?
- 7. What types of excuses do people use to put off the invitation by Christ?
- 8. What excuses do we make for our refusal to God's invitation? What are the things that hinders us from completely following Him?
- 9. How can you be like the servant, and invite people to check out God? Who will you focus on inviting this week?
