It's Not The End Of The Story

<u>Big Idea</u> When you've lost your hope, look for Jesus.

Luke 7:11-17

Luke 7:11-12

Options (Jesus):
-Do nothing
-Comfort the mom
-Bring the boy back to life

Key part of the story: verse 13 – When the Lord <u>saw her</u>, his heart <u>overflowed with compassion</u>.

Options in the face of loss (Mom)
-Do nothing
-Blame God
-Give up on life

How's your faith reservoir?
Flooding over or down to the last drop?
What have you left for dead because there is no way anything will ever change?
Is there something in your life where you would love to see Jesus touch the casket and say RISE?

Options (Me):
-Give up
-Leave Jesus
-Trust Jesus

<u>Talk It Over</u>

1. What different reactions do people have to the death of a friend?
2. What picture of Jesus do you take from this passage?
3. The authority and power of Jesus is put on display when he tells the dead man, "Get up" and he does. What are the spiritual/physical implications of this for today?
4. What were the crowd's reactions and conclusions concerning Jesus after this miracle? What can we learn from them?
5. Share something from your life in which you're hoping to experience the power, compassion, or authority of Jesus. What, from this story, gives you encouragement?
6. Is there something in your life where you would love to see Jesus touch the casket and say RISE?
