The Sabbath and Me

Big Idea We can only truly rest in God when we stop working.
Matthew 11:28-30, 12:1-14
Matthew 11:28-30: Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light."

Jesus because of their commitment to tradition.

Jesus has a rest that frees us from traditions about the Sabbath. The Pharisees rejected

Matthew 12:1: At about that time Jesus was walking through some grainfields on the **Sabbath**. His disciples were hungry, so they began breaking off some heads of grain and eating them.

Matthew 12:9-10: **Then** Jesus went over to their synagogue where he noticed a man with a deformed hand. The Pharisees asked Jesus, "Does the law permit a person to work by healing on the **Sabbath**?" (They were hoping he would say yes, so they could bring charges against him.)

I believe that today Sabbath is not a command that we are bound to; it's a promise that we are invited to enjoy.

Sabbath is a time to:

- -Practice for eternally being in God's presence
- -Practice trusting God
- -Create space for God to work in us
- -Create an opportunity for God to fill us
- -Take part in the new creation story
- -Remind ourselves of our Salvation and coming rest
