Setting the Stage

Elkanah had two wives: Hannah and Peninnah.  
Peninnah had children, but Hannah did not.

Peninnah would taunt Hannah and make fun of her  
because the Lord had kept her from having children.

Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the Lord.

Remember – Intervene

verse 20: and in due time she gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel, for she said, "I asked the Lord for him."
