Worshipful Thankfulness

Big Idea

God is worthy of all my worship and thanks.

Psalm 100:3, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20,
2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 11:33-36

Psalm 100:3

Acknowledge that the Lord is God!

He made us and we are his.

We are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

To acknowledge (know)
is to have firm ground underfoot.

The Lord is God and I am not.

The Lord is God – not anything else and not
anyone else.

I need to be convinced of it.
Absolutely no reservations.

Reasons for worshipping God:

1. He made us, and we are his.

“Of course, if we do not need God as our Creator, then we do not need to be thankful. Why should we? We got here by ourselves, thank you. We have no one but ourselves to thank.” -Boice

We are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

2. We are a new Creation.

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! -2 Corinthians 5:17

3. Everything is from God and for God.

God does not exist for me, I exist for Him.
