The Creator knows what's best for His creation.

Genesis 3:1-7, 4:1-12

Cain

Study Questions

1. What stood out to you, challenged you, or encouraged you from Sunday's sermon/service?
2. Discuss this statement, "The same power that raised Jesus from the dead is the same power we have to fight against the deceptions of the enemy." Is this true? Talk about the "power." How should we live in response to understanding this power? (Ephesians 1:19-20, 3:20, 2 Cor. 4:7)
3. How do we see the deception of Adam and Eve played out in our lives today? In our families? (Genesis 3). What lies, wrong voices and justifications are you subjected to in your life right now?
4. Pastor Kendall defined Safeguard as *a measure taken to protect someone or something or to prevent something undesirable*. What can we do to safeguard ourselves from believing lies, listening to the wrong voices, and justifying that our sin is okay?
5. God's first conversation with Cain is a series of questions. (V.6-7) What is God's desire for Cain?
6. Do you think God should have prevented Cain from murdering Abel? Why or why not? What is your choice when it comes to doing the right or the wrong?

Prayer Exercise: Read and pray Psalm 119:9-16 verse by verse in your group.
