<u>Big Idea</u>

Learn to expect the unexpected when

Jesus is involved.

Luke 1:5-25, 57-80

Story

- -400 years of silence is about to be broken
- -Luke 1:5-7 Introduction of Zechariah and Elizabeth
 - -Verse 7 They had no children because Elizabeth was unable to conceive, and they were both very old.
 - -"That one thing you must remember, or nothing that follows will seem wondrous."

The good news of God's presence, the story of Jesus's birth, begins in a most unexpected place – in the womb of a barren woman.

The birth of John the Baptist acts as a promise of everything God was about to do through Jesus – offering the world wholeness, healing, forgiveness, and joy.
Zechariah's song shows what God intends to provide for his people through Jesus.
Redemption / Promises Fulfilled / Mercy / Forgiveness / Salvation
