


Paradise Lost, Heaven Gained

<u>Big Idea</u>
I've read the end of the Bible, God wins!!!

Genesis 1-3, Revelation 21-22

The God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth and govern it. Reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, and all the animals that scurry along the ground." -Genesis 1:28





SIN – Not only was man's relationship with God damaged, but sin's entrance into the world also affected all of creation.

Talk It Over

<u>Ice Breaker</u>: What are some of the most beautiful places on earth (or beautiful architectural sites) you have seen? What makes them so striking?

- 1. The garden of Eden was the first place where God's space and humanity's space were one. Read Genesis 3 and discuss how these two spaces were driven apart.
- 2. In Romans 8:20, what explanation does Paul give for the current state of decay and frustration that exists in the created order? How would you say this in your own words, with your knowledge of Genesis 3 as a background?
- 3. How has the natural world helped you encounter God? What in the natural world helps you see God's goodness?
- 4. How is Revelation 22:1-6 the same as the garden of Eden (Genesis 2:4-17)? What is the significance of its differences to the garden of Eden?
- 5. Why do you think God will institute a new heaven and a new earth?
- 6. What are some of the details in Revelation 21:1-8 that speak to you about the intimacy of heaven or the emphasis on relationship? Which of these details is most significant to you and why?

<u>Pray</u>: Pray together and for each other Using Psalm 24:1-6 to begin.
