I want to be faithful to Christ

Colossians 2:6-7

Colossians 2:6-7

And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness.

Verse 6 – And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him.

“as you accepted”

When one accepts or receives Jesus Christ as Lord, one also accepts the obligation to live a certain way.

“continue to follow him”

The implication is that Christians must look to Christ alone.

Verse 7 – Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him...
