Finding Help When Getting a Drink of Water

Big Idea

Jesus knows what I need.

John 4

“For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. -John 3:16-17

Revelation: “I am the Messiah”

What is there that Jesus has for me
at the watering hole of my life?

Where is my "Jacob's Well"?

Where is Jesus, on purpose,
waiting to meet with me?

And I am certain that God, who began the
good work within you, will continue his work
until it is finally finished on the day when
Christ Jesus returns. -Philippians 1:6

They said to the woman, "We no longer believe
just because of what you said; now we have
heard for ourselves, and we know that this man
really is the Savior of the world." -John 4:42

Talk It Over

1. How do people satisfy their hungers and thirsts in life?
2. Read John 4:9-15. Jesus' words to the woman at the well in v 10 seems to imply that all people are spiritually thirsty. Does the woman seem spiritually thirsty at this point? What caused her deep thirst to surface? What does this teach us about our spiritual conversations with others?
3. In what ways do we miss what Jesus is trying to do in our life?
4. Talk about a time that you experienced Jesus' presence in your life, but you at first didn't recognize Him.
5. Water is used as a picture throughout Scripture, and here in John, Jesus declares that he is the Living Water. How is the picture of water used in the following verses: Jeremiah 2:13, Psalm 36:9, Isaiah 12:3, and Isaiah 44:3?
6. How would you describe the life of the Samaritan woman after her conversation with Jesus (v 26-30 and 39-42)? What did she do? How had she changed?
