Take Heaven Seriously

Big Idea

Heaven changes my life.

John 1:12, John 14:6, Matthew 6:19-21

Am I certain that I am Heaven bound?

Are you absolutely, 100 % certain that if you died today, you would be ushered by angels into the presence of God?

But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God. -John 1:12

Am I living for eternal things or temporary things?

“Do your current priorities and passions reveal an eternal or temporal perspective?” -Chip Ingram

Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be. -Matthew 6:19-21
