## Study Questions

1. What stood out to you, challenged you, or encouraged you from Sunday's sermon/service?
2. What are the answers to the prophet's questions in vs. 1? How does God reveal His message and His powerful arm in the world today? In your life?
3. How was Jesus a "man of sorrow" during His life on Earth? What does it mean that Jesus was a man of sorrow who knew grief?
4. The English word "despised" carries strong emotional overtones, but its Hebrew source means to be considered worthless and unworthy of attention. The Servant would not be the object of scorn, Isaiah meant, though He was that, as much as He would be hastily dismissed as insignificant. Do you see this attitude in the world? In yourself?
5. Read John 1:9-11 and Romans 10:16-17. How do these passages connect to the Isaiah verses?
