<u>Big Idea</u>
Fishing is sometimes more than just fishing.

rishing is servicin ness rivered in arrigest histining.
John 21:1-14
This story is a real-life experience in which the call of the mission can be clearly seen.
The focus of this story is not ' <u>why</u> ' Peter went fishing but on ' <u>how</u> ' his fishing went.
This story about 'fishing for fish' is really a story about 'fishing for people'.

Then he said, "Throw out your net on the right-hand side of the boat, and you'll get some!"

No questions. No conversation.

"So they did, and they couldn't haul in the net because there were so many fish in it."

This story is all about the Church on Mission:
The Mission of the Church is catching people. The Work of the Church is ultimately the work of God. The Life of the Church is participating in the presence of Christ.
The true catcher of fish is Jesus and not the disciples.
Hey Church- Jesus has the power to draw in fish when His disciples cannot do it on their own.
