Talk It Over

- 1. Take a moment to think about a time in your life when you experienced the joy and blessing of a deep, loving community? Where was it, and what made this community so different? What role did you play in this community?
- 2. Summarize the vision of the church God gives in Acts 2:42-47? How attracted to being a meaningful part of fulfilling this mission do you feel? Why?
- 3. Why do the activities listed in Acts 2:42-47 require intentionality—even under normal conditions, and how can we be "devoted" "day by day" to God and each other?
- 4. These four activities (apostles teaching, fellowship, breaking of bread, and prayer) are good indications of overall spiritual health. When you look at your own life, how many of these practices are you currently adhering to?
- 5. At the end of this text (Acts 2:46-47), the author lists out three results of doing church well. What are they?
