Reevaluating What is Priceless

<u>Big Idea</u>

I am ready to forsake it all for the call.

Philippians 3:7-11

I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done. Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my LordPhilippians 3:7-8a

For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ and become one with him. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith. -Philippians 3:8b-9

<u>Talk It Over</u>

Ice Breaker: Think of someone you know a lot about, but have never actually met. List a few things about them and see if your group can guess who it is.

1. Paul emphasizes the knowledge of Christ in this passage. What is the difference between knowing Jesus and knowing about Him? How can you be sure you actually know Him?

2. What is the most important thing to you in life? What would others say is the most important thing in your life?

3. In verse 8, Paul states that he considers everything else a loss compared to "knowing Christ as Lord". What do you think it practically looks like in daily living to consider everything else a loss compared to knowing Christ as Lord? How can you make steps toward this mindset? Discuss the struggle.

4. Read Philippians 3:7-9 (also Acts 9:1-17 if time allows). Paul explains his conversion and the resulting life change. His conversion radically changed his life. What is one thing that's happened in your life that has radically changed you?

5. Paul says he wants to "know the power of His resurrection." How does knowing God and his power affect your daily life?
