Talk It Over

3. Why might Paul say "make every effort" when he talks about keeping unity in the Spirit? What new "effort(s)" do you feel led to make toward keeping unity with fellow believers in our church and beyond?
4. What challenges do you face individually in keeping yourself united in the Spirit and bound together in peace with other believers?
5. What challenges face our church in keeping our "little c" church united in the Spirit and bound together in peace?
6. How are we enabled to live in unity and peace within the body of Christ? (v.4-7)
