**The Door of Invitation**

Big Idea

Eternal life is found only by entering  
through the door of Christ.

John 10:6-10

Context

In this passage, Jesus Christ, the Lord and Savior, reveals profound truths about His identity and mission. He declares Himself as the Door (Gate) of the sheep, emphasizing His role as the exclusive means through which believers can enter into salvation and eternal life.

When Jesus states, "I am the door of the sheep," He is declaring His unique position as the sole access point to God and His kingdom.

Jesus contrasts Himself with others who have come before Him, identifying them as thieves and robbers.

This serves as a warning to remain true to God's Word, and a warning against teachings that are far from Christ's truth.

In stating, "Those who come in through me will be saved," Jesus emphasizes that salvation is not just possible but assured for those who come to Him in faith.

The declaration that "The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy," starkly contrasts with Jesus' purpose. Jesus says, "My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life."

John 14:6 - Jesus as the way, truth, and life

Psalms 23:1 - The Lord as our shepherd

Romans 6:23 - The gift of eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord
